ORDER

At Butte in said District this 13th day of November, 2003.

To clarify Mont. LBR 2090-5, and the procedure required for an attorney to withdraw from representation after making a temporary appearance on behalf of an absent attorney at a court hearing or § 341 meeting for which the attorney making the temporary appearance has filed a F.R.B.P. 2016(b) disclosure statement,

IT IS ORDERED that Mont. LBR 2090-5, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph (c):

(c) If an attorney makes a temporary appearance on behalf of an absent attorney who represents a debtor at a court hearing or §341 meeting *and* has filed a F.R.B.P. 2016(b) disclosure statement, the attorney making the temporary appearance may withdraw from further representing such debtor in other matters or proceedings by filing a Notice of Withdrawal of Temporary Representation of

Attorney for Debtor(s) Reflecting No Change in Original Attorney. Such withdrawal of temporary representation shall be effective immediately upon filing, without further notice, hearing or order.
