ORDER 22-1

The Military Entrance Processing Station (“MEPS”) has historically requested permission to use the Courtroom for various ceremonies. In conjunction with requesting such permission, MEPS has also requested permission to bring electronic equipment into the Courtroom. This Court has routinely granted permission for MEPS to both utilize the Courtroom and bring electronic equipment to MEPS ceremonies.

Pursuant to Mont. LBR 5073-1(G) and for the remainder of the 2022 calendar year, any permission given by the Court to MEPS to utilize the Courtroom shall include permission to bring electronic equipment, including tablets, cameras, and cell phones into the Mike Mansfield Courthouse. Any use of such electronics shall be restricted to MEPS ceremonies or receptions.
