

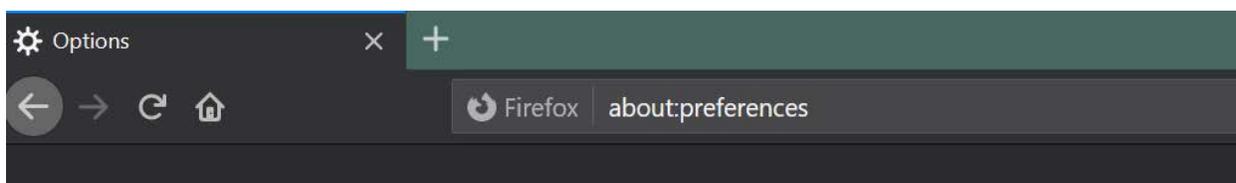
## Setting Browser to open PDFs in Adobe

Firefox:

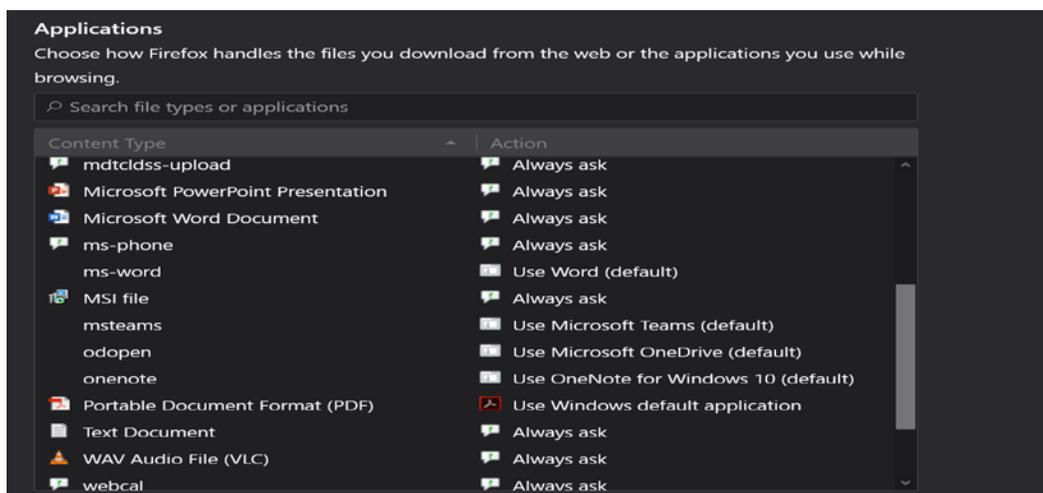
Open Firefox



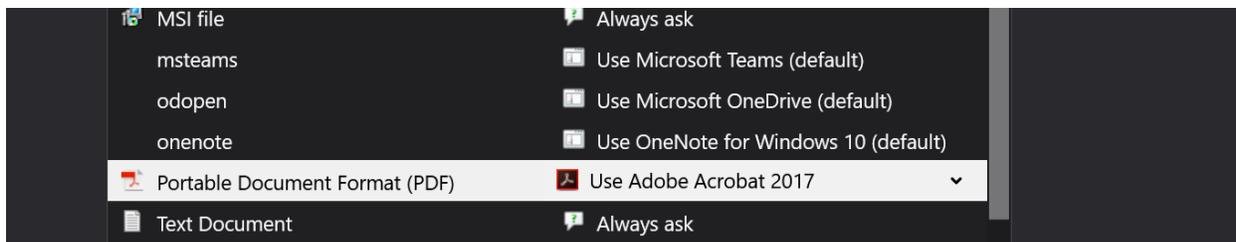
Type `about:preferences` in the Firefox Address Bar. This will bring up options.



On the General Page, scroll down to Applications.



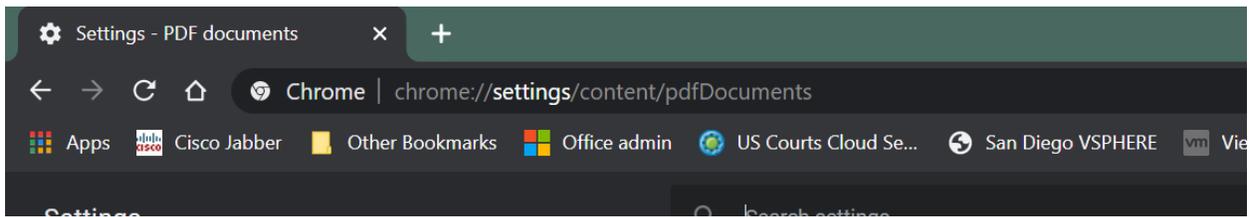
To the right of Portable Document Format (PDF) – select the drop down and choose Adobe Acrobat.



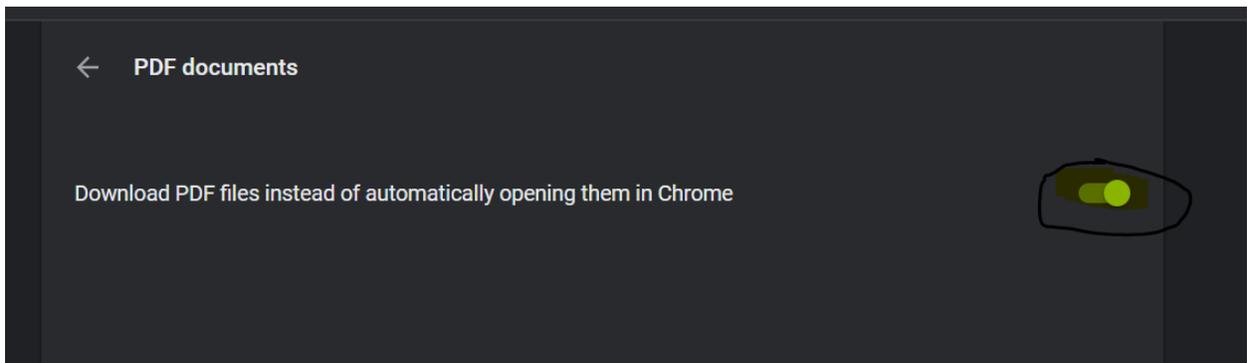
Chrome:



Type `chrome://settings/content/pdfDocuments` in the Chrome address bar.



Make sure Download PDF files instead of automatically opening them in Chrome is turned on. That way you can open the document in Adobe Acrobat.



Internet Explorer:



Click the Gear Icon under exit and scroll down to Manage Add Ins.



Make Sure Adobe PDF Reader is Disabled (it is enabled by default).
