By General Order No. 2020-4-BPH, this Court adopted procedures intended to maintain the administration of cases while minimizing opportunities for exposure to COVID-19. This Order supplements General Order 2020-4 entered by this Court on March 16, 2020.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, until further order of the Court:


1. The United States Trustee shall not schedule § 341 Meetings in the Courthouses. All new § 341 Meetings shall be scheduled telephonically. Local Bankruptcy Rule 2003-3, § 341 Meetings may be conducted either telephonically or by video conference. Debtors shall comply with Local Bankruptcy Rule 2003-5 and utilize the method of participation stated by the United States Trustee in his instructions for participants in Telephonic Meetings of Creditors. The requirement in Local Bankruptcy Rule 2003-5 that Debtors sign a Declaration of Debtor(s)

Under Penalty of Perjury form (Mont. LBF 36) and that the Trustee or U.S. Trustee retain the declaration is hereby suspended.

2. In addition to identifying the dates of § 341 Meetings, the United States Trustee shall provide the Clerk of Court's office with a dial in phone number, a specific time to call in for each case, and instructions that the Clerk of Court shall incorporate into its official forms and notices for mailing to creditors.

3. Parties shall comply with instructions provided by the U.S. Trustee, or case Trustee in the notice.
